- · Completed a minimum of undergraduate theological education (Bachelor of Theology)
- · Ordained, or willing and able to be ordained in the IREC
- · Has at least 2 years of experience in pastoral ministry with young people
- An excellent communicator and effective biblical teacher/preacher to both those who are believers and those exploring Christianity
- Relational, having a heart to care for people, especially in one-on-one ministry
- Able to work with a wide age range of members, but especially with teenagers and young adults
- · Organized and proactive
- Has leadership abilities as a member of a team and work independently in the development of agreed upon vision and goals
- An ideal candidate would have a familiarity with Southeast Asian cultures
